BEGIN WRESTLING: STANDARD FORMAT - All wrestling to begin at 9:00 AM and proceed until brackets are completed.

All age groups will wrestle on a min. of ½ mat, we hope to have all matches on full mats.

BRACKETS: Double elimination brackets will be used with some round robin brackets where needed to facilitate more matches for the wrestlers. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to combine weight classifications within age groups to maximize number of matches for wrestlers and for better operation of the tournament. "A" & "B" brackets will be created when number of entries and ability levels make this possible. PLEASE include ability ranking and "seedable" information for your wrestlers in entries, to assist us in bracketing.
Please indicate the wrestler's ability by:

A = Advanced (Usually 1st/2nd, State qualifier or above)

B = Good (Usually 3rd/4th, District tournament qualifier, etc.)

C = Average (Sometimes places in top four)

D = Beginner

AWARDS: Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places.

RULES: High school with Kansas Kids adaptations.

All wrestlers are required to wear headgear & have shoelaces "secured".

Wrestlers may compete in only one Age & Weight Division (No "double dipping")

6, 8 & 10U Divisions will wrestle 1:00 min. periods, 12 & 14U will wrestle 1:30 periods
